

Speeding, Aggressive Driving Action Plan

**DRAFT Action Plan –Speeding, Aggressive Driving**

<b>CEA # 6</b>	Speeding Aggressive Driving
<b>Strategy # 1</b>	Convince the public that punishment is likely
<b>Targets</b>	The motoring public especially repeat offenders
<b>Description</b>	Enact “Aggressive Driving” statute (First offense - \$200 fine; Second and subsequent offenses – 5 point penalty)
<b>Actions</b>	<p><b>Step 1 – Research data mined from law enforcement and judicial system regarding citations, arrests and convictions pertaining to aggressive driving.</b></p> <p><b>Step 2 – Compile data concerning motor vehicle injuries and deaths caused by aggressive driving.</b></p> <p><b>Step 3 – Propose amendments to VSA to accomplish this strategy.</b></p> <p><b>Step 4 – Monitor Legislative progress.</b></p>
<b>Time Frame</b>	Enact legislation by end of the 2008 Legislative session
<b>Output</b>	A new law that provides for the arrest and conviction of individuals charged with “aggressive driving,” and appropriate penalties.
<b>Data Needed</b>	Incidents of motor vehicle crashes resulting in injuries or death cause by aggressive driving.
<b>Data Collection (how, by whom)</b>	Necessary data can be resourced in the law enforcement community and Vermont’s judicial system.
<b>Performance Measure</b>	Enactment of legislation to penalize aggressive driving, and a reduction in crashes caused by aggressive driving.
<b>Funding</b>	To be determined.
